We currently have a limited number of spaces available for international families who wish to enrol their children at our welcoming, safe and friendly school.

Roydvale School is situated in suburban, Northwest Christchurch. Set in spacious grounds the school has fourteen classrooms, a library, a swimming pool, two adventure playgrounds and a hall. The



school also has a tennis court, netball and basketball courts and a large sports field.

There are around 300 children who attend Roydvale. Our children are very friendly and welcoming to new children who come to our school. International Students who enrol at Roydvale are able to experience a unique education. Their English speaking skills will be developed while they participate in a variety of learning experiences, both inside and outside the classroom, that will provide them with many happy memories for the rest of their life.

Roydvale School is a very safe school. Our teachers are recognised for providing a high quality teaching experience to the students in our school.

We have an emphasis on Maths and English in order to give all students a solid foundation for their future schooling, but students also receive quality teaching in all New Zealand curriculum subjects.

English Lessons

We are fortunate to have a very experienced English teacher, Mrs Jade Yoong. Mrs Yoong has taught English to Roydvale students who come from a non-English speaking background for the past fifteen years. Being able to speak six languages herself, Mrs Yoong spends four, half-hour individual sessions a week with International Students developing all aspects of their English



language skills. Students quickly pick up English as a result of Mrs Yoong's teaching. International Students come to Roydvale knowing only one or two words of English, they often leave a year later being able to speak fluent English and are confident to speak in front of our whole school.

At Roydvale we limit our International Student intake, meaning International Students have more opportunities to interact with native speakers of English.

Comments From Past International Students

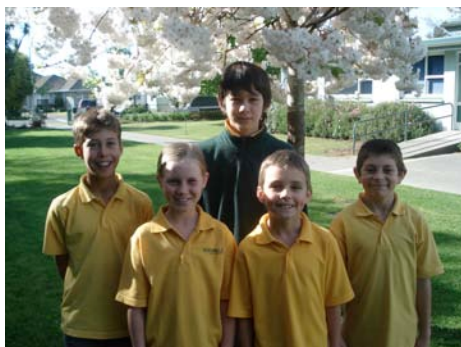
We think Roydvale School is a very special place. When students have completed their time at Roydvale, we ask them for their thoughts on their experience. This is what our previous International Students have said about our school.
