The final list of items in the Silent Auction is listed at the end of this newsletter.

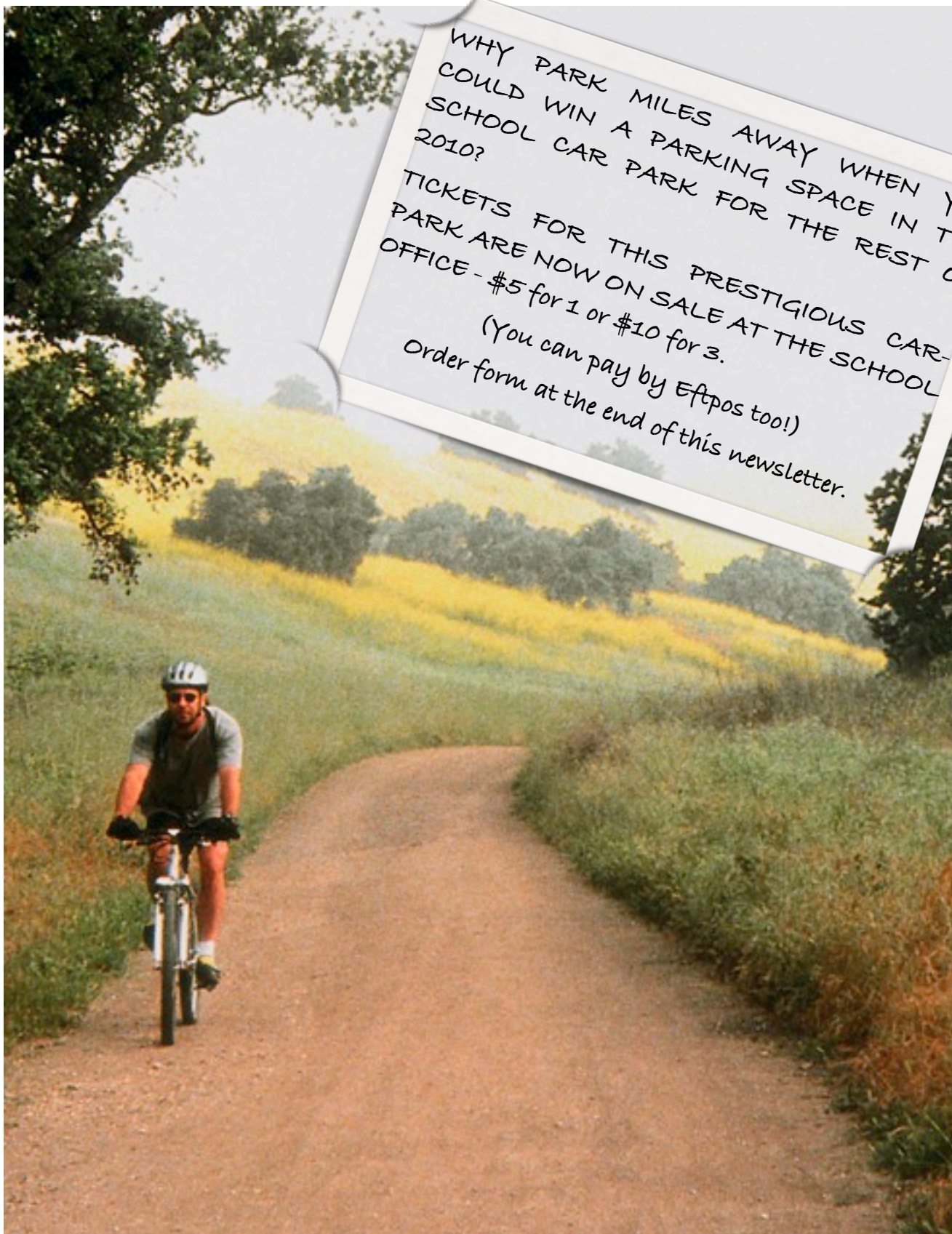
